- Our school was first built as a military office facility and later converted to a school
- As a school, our building has been expanded multiple times
- We have a very old and leaking roof that will be renovated by the Kodiak Borough this summer
- We are in the Borough designated tsunami zone, and evacuate onto Base and rendezvous at the runway tower on Base
- About 30% of our students enroll and unenroll each year
- In FY24 we enrolled about 60 students within just a couple of weeks of school starting





Above Benchmark 💠





Peterson School Counselor Tiers of Support

Tier 1

 All students receive at least 30 min of class lessons a week that align with American School Counselor Association Mindsets and Behaviors (10 weekly lessons)

Tier 2

 Offering weekly lunch bunches or small group meetups for new students, transferring students, students with deployed parents, etc. (currently facilitating 12 groups)

Tier 3

- May include intermittent individual meetings over the course of six weeks, which include more direct support or skill development
- Student crisis response
- IEP services for 4 students

- Jobs develop leadership, accountability, pride, responsibility, excitement, positive connection, and community in a meaningful way




